



BRAZILIAN WAXING AT HEAVENLY ESCAPE

Here is a list frequently asked questions. We hope this helps with your decision to wax or not to wax.

Why Is It So Popular?

- A Brazilian is more hygienic
- You will feel fresher
- It is great to have a Brazilian before baby comes (less mess)
- Men love it (you will too!)

What Is Involved?

Brazilian waxing is the removal of pubic hair leaving a strip at the front or none. We are very thorough in our salons - you will not find a hair left front to back.

How Long Does It Take?

A Brazilian wax can take from 25 mins up to 45 mins depending on the hair growth and length of time since the last waxing treatment.

Should I Do Anything Before My Wax?

Please do not shave for at least 3 weeks prior to your wax. For women, try to make your appointment just after your menstrual cycle as you are a little less sensitive at that time. For your own comfort, if you have not had a Brazilian before or it has been a while between waxing sessions (over 6 weeks), we advise you to trim hair down to around 1cm. This minimises the pull on the hair, and makes the process a lot more comfortable for you.

What Kind Of Hygiene Precautions Do We Take at Heavenly Escape?

We use disposable wooden spatulas and do not double dip. Your therapist will supply you with a fresh disposable wipe for you to freshen up prior to the treatment. We disinfect the area and then apply a pre-waxing oil for your comfort and ease of hair removal. At the end of your waxing treatment, a soothing aloe gel is applied, followed by a cold compress if required (usually not).

What Makes Our Brazilians Different From The Rest?

No other Brazilian wax will be the same as ours. At Heavenly Escape we use our own blend of Brazilian wax, made right here in the salon. Our special blend consists of a wax that has excellent pull for shorter stubborn hairs and is combined with another wax that has the most soothing and gentle effect on the skin. Our therapists are also trained to give Brazilian waxes in a gentle and caring manner and are extremely thorough.

Is The Procedure Painful?

On the whole most women are pleasantly surprised to see that it's not really too painful. For those who are a little more sensitive to waxing due to strength of their hair or density, at Heavenly Escape we have a lot of techniques to help you through the process.

Can Men Have Brazilians

The answer there is **YES**, At Heavenly Escape we do male Brazilian waxes, but only on **referral**. We have a number of male clients who receive waxing treatments on a regular basis.
